## IV International Conference in Linguistics Applied to Foreign Language Teaching: **Towards Plurilingualism**

Nebrija University is pleased to invite you to the ***IV International Conference of Linguistics Applied to Foreign Language Teaching***, to be held June 27-29, 2019 at the Madrid-Princesa campus.

### **PRESENTATION**

The Conference aims to be **a meeting point for researchers and teachers - experts or novices - and to contribute to the development and dissemination of new work** in the fields of Linguistics Applied to Foreign Language Teaching Methodology.

The official languages of the Conference are **English, French, German and Spanish**, with a specific panel for each of them, composed of the following sections: **oral presentations, workshops, posters and junior research projects**.

In this fourth edition of the International Nebrija Conference we have included **Galician** and **Arabic** as special guest languages.

The programme is rounded off with a series of **plenary talks** given by leading international experts and relating to the most relevant Conference themes.

Participants will receive a certificate of 20 hours training.

## **GUIDELINES FOR PAPERS, WORKSHOPS AND POSTERS**

Contributions will be presented in the language of the corresponding language panel and will be related to the teaching methodology of that language (English, French, German, Spanish, Galician and Arabic). A maximum of two contributions per author can be accepted. In the case of contributions in Arabic, visual aids in Spanish or English are recommended, in order to facilitate attendance of participants from other language communities.

**Oral presentations:** Oral presentations should have a predominantly theoretical content based on research results related to the thematic lines of the Conference. The allotted time for each presentation is 20 minutes, to be followed by ten minutes for discussion. Presentations may be co-authored.

**Workshops:** Workshops will be delivered in 60 minutes and have a practical approach (explanation of teaching experiences, new projects for foreign language teaching, development of educational activities, etc.). They must follow workshop standards by involving attendees actively. The workshops may be co-authored by a maximum of three authors. Workshops will not be published in the conference proceedings.

**Posters:** Posters will show both research findings and classroom experiences and will be on display throughout the Conference. Furthermore, a specific time in the program will be allotted for the authors to give a short 5 minute presentation about their work and to answer questions. Posters may be co-authored.

Junior researchers will have 15 minutes to present their bachelor theses, with five more minutes of discussion with the audience.

## **AWARDS**

- The author of the best bachelor thesis presented at the Conference (according to an Assessment Committee) will be awarded a scholarship consisting of a

50% discount on the enrolment fee in an official Master's degree of the Applied Languages Department in Nebrija University (*Máster Universitario en Lingüística Aplicada a la Enseñanza de Español como Lengua Extranjera, Máster Universitario en Enseñanza Bilingüe para Profesores de Enseñanza Primaria y Secundaria or Máster Universitario en Formación del Profesorado de ESO y Bachillerato, FP y Enseñanza de idiomas*).

- The author (or authors) of the best poster presented, selected by an Assessment Committee, will have the opportunity to attend, free of charge, all the training activities organised by Nebrija University throughout the year free of charge (*Aula de Español, Aula Plurilingüe, Foro Internacional del Español Nebrija-SGEL, Foro Nebrija en Enseñanza Bilingüe, Encuentro Universitario de Traducción e Interpretación Profesional*).

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR PROPOSAL SUBMISSION

Proposals for presentations, workshops and posters will be examined and, if appropriate, approved for presentation in a blind peer review process. All proposals must be sent using the form available at the Conference website, indicating the type of contribution (presentation, workshop or poster) and the panel (ESL, DaF, FLe, etc.). Proposals must include:

- Title
- Type of contribution: presentation, workshop, poster or bachelor thesis
- Full name of the author/authors, postal address, telephone and e-mail of the author/authors
- Work or Study Centre
- Abstract (maximum 500 words) explaining topic, objectives, conclusions, and references as clearly and specifically as possible
- Technical media required for the presentation
- Brief CV of the author/authors (maximum 10 lines)

Once a proposal has been accepted, at least one of the authors must be registered as a participant. Otherwise, the contribution will be removed. Moreover, no certificate will be issued to any author who has not paid the registration fees for the Conference.

## PUBLICATION OF PROCEEDINGS

Only papers and posters will be considered for their publication in the Proceedings (to be made available on the Conference web page). In addition, a selection of relevant
